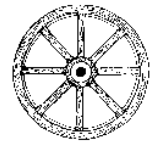

RECYCLE – Please bring all your drink containers (aluminum and plastic only) to the Heritage Ranch recycle center rather than putting them in your trash. These containers will be marked “CA Cash Refund” or “CA CRV” (CRV stands for California Redemption Value) and you pay into the fund when you purchase these items.
