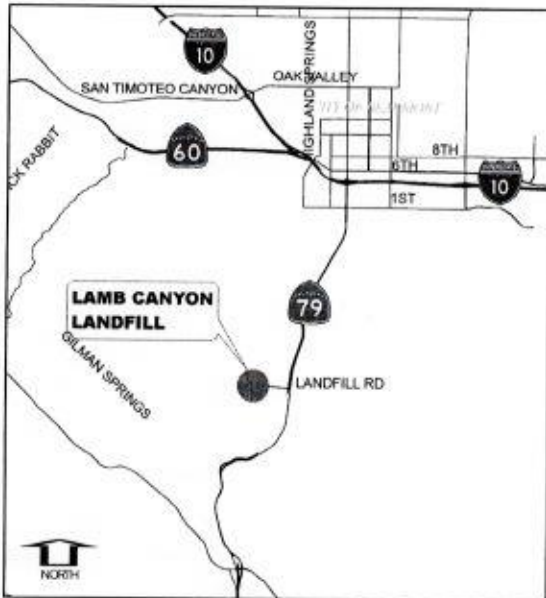

The most common items you will find in your home are fluorescent light bulbs, batteries, cleaning/gardening chemicals, paint (empty containers can go in the trash), old prescriptions and all electronics (TVs, computers, etc.). Please collect these items for turn in at the Lamb Canyon Landfill on May 14<sup>th</sup>.

# Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility

NOTE: Event may be cancelled due to rain, snow or excessive winds or other hazardous conditions as determined by County.

**Location: Lamb Canyon Sanitary Landfill**  
**16411 Lamb Canyon Road**  
**Beaumont, CA 92223**



## Directions:

Proceed west on I-10, exit Hwy 79 south (Beaumont Avenue). Go south to Lamb Canyon Landfill Road and turn west into landfill.

From Hwy 60, travel east, and merge with I-10 east, exit at Beaumont Avenue (Hwy 79). Turn south. Go south to Lamb Canyon Landfill Road and turn west into landfill.

From Gilman Springs Road/State Street in San Jacinto, turn north onto Hwy 79. Proceed to Lamb Canyon Landfill Road and turn west into landfill.

- ✓ **Household Hazardous Waste Only-No Business Waste**
- ✓ **Each load shall not exceed 15 gallons of liquid waste or a total of 125 pounds—Multiple trips are allowed**
- ✓ **Containers shall be marked and secured to prevent leaks. Place unused medication in a clear zip lock bag. (Controlled Substances prohibited)**
- ✓ **Containers holding gasoline will not be returned**

## Acceptable Items

- Used Oil and Filters
- Latex/Oil-Based Paint
- Fluorescent Tubes/Bulbs
- Pesticides
- Cleaners
- BBQ & Camp Size Propane
- Aerosol Cans
- Antifreeze
- Auto/Household Batteries
- Garden Chemicals
- Pool Chlorine
- TVs and Computers
- Electronic Waste
- Sharps
- Unused medication (except controlled substances)

## Unacceptable Items

- Government, Business, Non-Profit, or Out-of-County Hazardous Waste
- Explosives or Ammunition
- Controlled Substances
- Infectious Waste (except Sharps)
- Asbestos
- Radioactive (except smoke detectors)
- Remediation Material
- Containers larger than 5 gallons or weighing more than 50 pounds
- Appliances
- Tires
- Trash
